# Glossary

# Additive

Created with light. Start with Black, add RGB.

Analogous Colors At least three colors, side-by-side.

# **Color Harmony**

How the colors interact & work together in your artwork.

# **Color Scheme**

An arrangement of colors that is generally considered pleasing to look at. The popular color schemes used by artists are *complementary*, *analogous*, *triadic*, *split-complementary*, and *rectangular*.

# **Complementary Colors**

Opposite sides of the Color Wheel

**Cool Colors** Do not contain any Reds.

# **Double Complementary Colors**

Two Hues next to each other on the Color Wheel, and are paired with two adjacent Hues on the opposite side.

# **High-Key**

The range of lighter values (light colors).

#### Hue

Refers to the dominant color wavelength, and ignores value & saturation.

#### Low-Key

The range of darker values (dark colors).

Luminance (Value) A measure of how light or dark something is.

Monochromatic A single Hue, plus it's shades tones, & tint.

# Neutral

Colors that are not found on the Color Wheel, such as Grey, Beige, & Brown.

# Opacity, Opaque

The measure of impenetrability of solid color by transparency or translucence.

## **Primary Colors**

Red, Blue, & Yellow.

# Saturation (Chroma, Intensity, Purity, Richness, Vividness)

The measure of the intensity a color has.

# Secondary Colors

Green, Orange, Violet

**Shade** A color plus black.

# **Split Complementary Colors**

A Primary Color is paired with the two Analogous colors to its complement.

### Subtractive

Created with ink. Start with White, add CMYK.

### Temperature

Refers to how warm or cool a color is.

**Tertiary Colors** The six other colors of the wheel that are neither Primary or Secondary.

Red-Orange, Red-Violet, Yellow-Orange, Yellow-Green, Blue-Violet, Blue-Green.

#### Tint

A color plus white.

#### Tone

A color mixed with grey to reduce purity.

# Translucence

Allowing some colors of light pass through an object.

#### Transparency

Allowing light to pass through an object.

Triad (Triangle) Equally spaced around the Color Wheel

# Warm Colors Do not contain any Blues.
