JSON Cheatsheet

- JavaScript Object Notation
- Data exchanged between a browser and a server can only be text.
- Any JavaScript object can be converted to JSON.
- JSON files use .json extension & "application/json" MIME type.

JSON Syntax Rules

- Data is in name/value pairs. A name/value pair consists of "name":"Cloud"
- Name & string values require double quotes.
- Value can be a string, number, JSON Object, Array, Boolean, or Null.
- Data is separated by commas.
- Curly braces hold objects.
- Square brackets hold arrays.
